## Enrollment 2026-27 School Year

**Hello St. Paul Families,**

Enrollment time is here! While enrollment for current families officially begins on January 12, 2026, those who already know they will be returning for the 2026–2027 school year are welcome to enroll early by following the directions below. Early enrollment helps us begin planning for accurate class sizes, staffing needs, and tuition rates.

As you know, our classes fill very quickly and we anticipate some wait lists. To ensure your child's spot for next year, please complete the online enrollment as soon as possible.

### Enrollment Protocol for 2026–2027

We will follow the timeline below and create waiting lists once grades reach capacity:

- **Jan 12** – Current Families
- **Jan 26** – Parish Families
- **Feb 9** – Divine Mercy & Holy Family
- **Feb 17** – All Other Catholic Families
- **Feb 23** – Non-Catholic Families

4. Once logged in, click **Complete Family/Student Registration Information for Next Year** and carefully review and update your information.
5. Proceed through each child's page, updating any necessary information, and click **Continue**.
6. After all pages are updated, click **Complete Registration**. Your child(ren) will then be enrolled for the **2026–2027** school year.

### Adding a New Student or Preschooler

If you are enrolling an additional child or a preschool student, please email **Adriana Braswell** (abraswell@stpaul.eduk12.net) to confirm available space and receive the correct enrollment forms.

### Enrollment Fees K-8

Enrollment fees will be added to your FACTS account once your enrollment is complete.

- 1 child – **\$300**
- 2 children – **\$425**
- 3 or more – **\$500**

### Preschool Enrollment Fee - \$190

**New this year:** The enrollment fee now includes PTO dues, technology fees, and testing fees. This means no additional fees will be added in September, a change from what we have done in the past.

The enrollment fee must be paid in full no later than **April 30, 2026**.

**Please note that we are unable to finalize enrollment for the upcoming school year if there is a remaining balance from the previous year.**

We are looking forward to all the great things to come in the 2026–2027 school year.

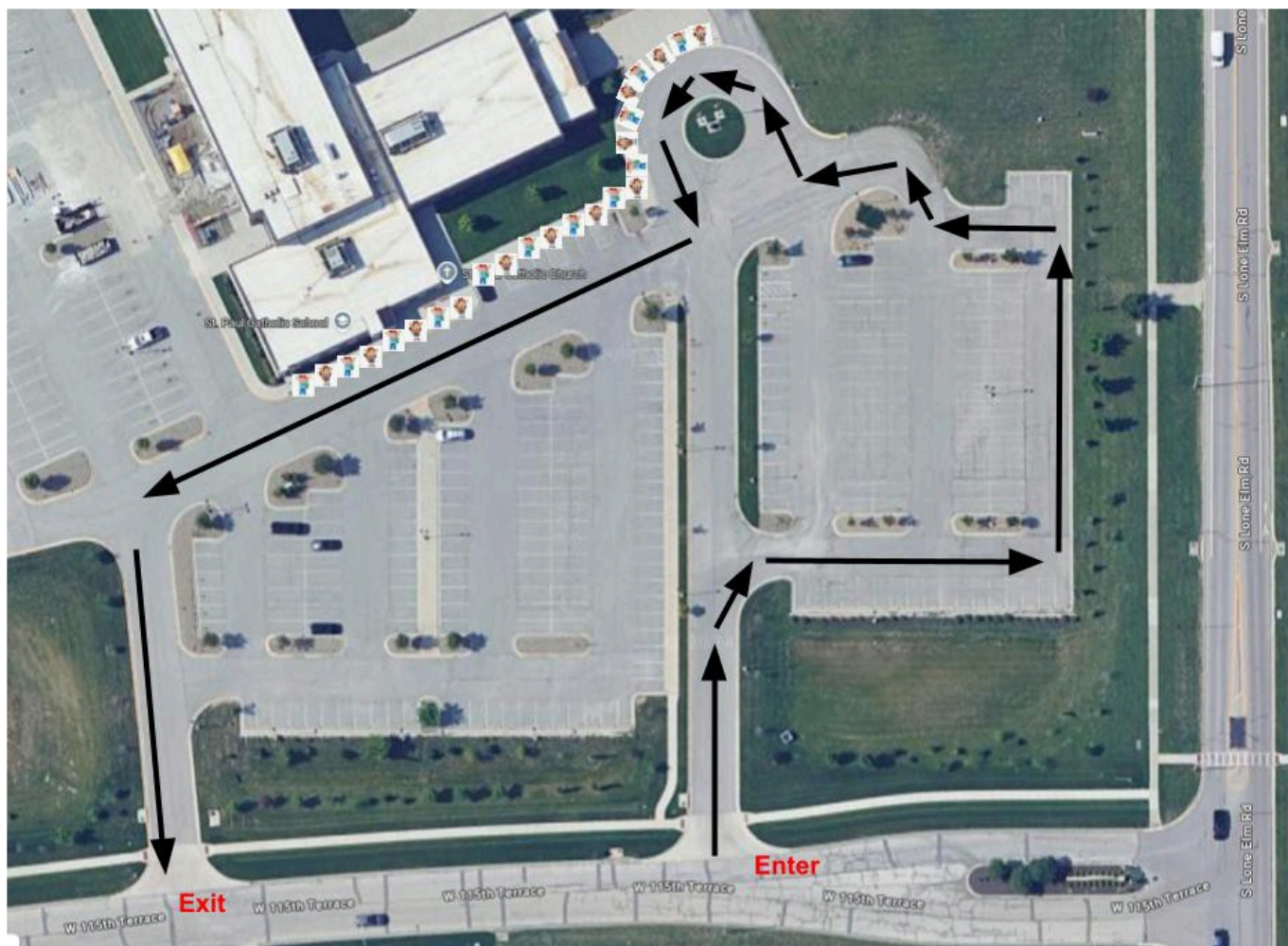
Thank you for living out the spirit of stewardship and for being such an incredible community of faith. It is a true blessing to serve alongside families like you.

## Car Line

As we start the second semester, just a reminder about drop off and pick up. In the mornings, our goal is to unload as many cars as possible. If your car is in front of the sidewalk (see photo), please have all your children exit out of the car and walk to the sidewalk and into the building. When one car does not unload while the cars around it do, it slows down the carline. When pulling in front of the school to drop off, please pull all the way to the mailbox.

For dismissal, please don't call your child over to you. Your child has been instructed to stay at a cone, in order to keep the cars in line for all the other cones. Please don't call your child to your car a few cones down, because it pushes back every car behind you.

Please pull all the way forward when instructed. The cones are spaced for the safety of the children. When parents don't pull up far enough, it puts kids in a position to step into traffic to get to their cars, which we do not want. Teachers are there to help your kids in and out of their vehicles.
