Uniform Reminder

Just a few reminders and we move from Fall to Winter:

- Our uniform pants/shorts are to be navy blue. Black and Khaki are not part of our uniform.
- Please label all sweatshirts and outerwear. Our lost and found is full of items with no name.
- Only Garfield plaid from Tommy Hilfiger and Dennis Uniform are allowed. Please check to make sure your plaid is not French Toast or another brand.
- Uniform shorts can no longer be worn after November 1st.
- Girls may wear nail polish but artificial nails are not allowed, this includes "press on" nails.
- Long sleeve shirts worn under short sleeve uniform shirts must be the same color as the shirt.

Now that the temperatures are getting colder, please make sure that your children are dressed for the weather. Please check the handbook for appropriate cold weather options to be worn during class. Non-St. Paul hoodies and jackets may not be worn inside during the school day. Also, tennis shoes are the only shoes students should be wearing during the school day.

Inclement Weather Information

If the decision is made to close school due to weather-related events, you will receive an email through EduConnect email as soon as the decision is made. Updates will also be posted on our social media pages — please be sure to follow St. Paul Catholic School on Instagram and Facebook to stay informed.

Our spring parent survey showed overwhelming support for a 2-hour delay option when needed. Therefore, if a late start is necessary, school will begin at 9:50 a.m., with doors opening at 9:30 a.m. There will be no morning preschool on these days.

While we have typically followed the Olathe School District's weather-related closures, we will continue to evaluate our options and communicate directly with families when decisions are made. Because our students and staff come from many different zip codes, weather conditions can vary greatly, and we want to make the best decision for everyone's safety.

Please note that we do not close school early once students are already in attendance, but parents are always welcome to pick up their child early if they feel it is necessary. We also build snow days into our calendar each year in case closures become necessary.
